Our conference opens on Sunday, June 27, and concludes on Wednesday, June 30. One-hour workshop sessions will run Monday, June 28, and Tuesday, June 29. Submit your proposal today!

If you have an expertise in youth leadership or chapter development or extensive knowledge in the areas of alcohol and other drug use, safe driving issues, teen violence, body image, suicide, or one of the many other issues facing young people today, please submit a proposal. Workshop Format & Expectations

Each workshop will be *one hour* in length. We will provide you with an estimate of the number of participants to expect when workshops are finalized. Conference participants are current middle school or high school students and adult advisors or chaperones.

- Present a program or activity that is relevant to one of the topic areas listed below and aligned with SADD's mission.
- Engage participants in a dynamic, interactive learning process.
- Provide participants with concrete tools and advice they can bring back to their own schools and communities.

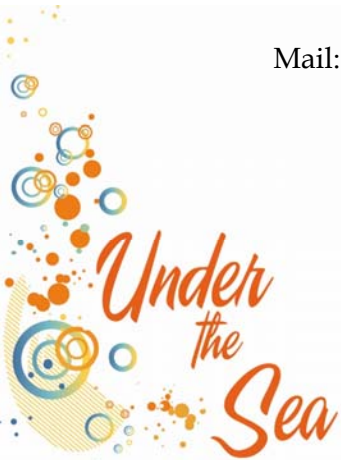
